

More Ways to Save Money on Prescriptions

Prescription costs are among the fastest growing expenses in health care, but there are ways to slow the flow of cash out of your pocket!

1 Generics
Often there are several drugs available to treat the same condition. Try generic medications which have the same active ingredients as brand-name medications, but are substantially less expensive. Your pharmacist may be able to recommend, or your doctor may be able to prescribe a cheaper option at a lower cost for you.

2 90 Day Generic Maintenance Drug Program[†]
Save more by receiving 90-day fills of tier 1 or tier 2 generic maintenance medications. See your drug formulary at deancare.com/pharmacybenefits.

Member cost share for 90-day fills* are:

- 2 times your copay for all tier 1 and tier 2 medications through a mail-order pharmacy
- 2.5 times your copay for tier 1 and tier 2 generic maintenance medications at retail pharmacies

Note: Members with tier 1 or tier 2 pharmacy benefits with coinsurance will still be charged the full coinsurance amount.

3 Mail Order*
Why spend time and money driving to the pharmacy when you can have your medicine delivered free to your door? Refill prescriptions by phone or online for 90 days on select medications. Visit deancare.com/pharmacycostsavings to learn more.

4 Take Advantage of Copay Cards**
Copay cards can often be used with commercial insurance to reduce your out-of-pocket cost. Whether your plan requires a copay, coinsurance, or the full drug cost for high-deductible plans, copay cards can save you money. They are often available for newer brand-name drugs that do not yet have a generic available.

You can find copay cards on needymeds.org, the drug manufacturer's website, or by speaking with your pharmacist. You may need to enroll in a program before using the card.

5 Compare Prices
You can often find the same quality product for a much better price if you check around. That's what our **Cost Compare** tool is all about. Just log into your account on deancare.com. Cost Compare lets you search drugs at nearby network pharmacies, gives you accurate price estimates based on your benefit plan and offers 24/7- access on any device—smartphone, tablet or computer.

6 Preventive Drug List[†]
More common medications available without a copay to reduce barriers and help you better manage your health. The preventive medications found on the preventive drug list protect against or manage some high-risk medical conditions. Taking these medications regularly as prescribed can help avoid serious health problems or complications, reducing the number of doctor visits and hospitalizations.
