

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
The County of Dane
and the
WISCONSIN PROFESSIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION, SUPERVISORY LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT (“WPPA-
Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit”)
Indigenous People’s Day**

1. Dane County Board of Supervisors, 2023 OA- 065, has established the second Monday of October as Indigenous People’s Day making it an official Dane County Holiday.

2. 10.01 Holidays. All full-time employees covered by the terms of this Agreement shall be entitled to the following named holidays, with pay: January 1st, third Monday in January (Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr.), last Monday in May (Memorial Day), June 19th (Juneteenth) July 4th (Independence Day), the first Monday in September (Labor Day), **second Monday of October**, the 4th Thursday of November (Thanksgiving Day), the day first following Thanksgiving, December 24th, December 25th and December 31st in each year.

3. This agreement may be modified at any time during the period of the MOU, based on mutual agreement of both parties. This agreement shall expire December 14, 2024 unless both parties agree to the extension of said agreement.
