ADMINISTRATIVE PRACTICES MANUAL

SUBJECT: TITLE CHANGE OF A POSITION OR CLASSIFICATION

DEFINITIONS:

Title Changes are defined in Dane County Ordinance, Chapter 18: Section 18.04; as,

"(44m) Title change shall mean a change in the title of a position or classification based on market reasons that demonstrate a change is necessary to more accurately describe the work that a position or classification performs. A title change does not mean a change in the position or classification's responsibilities or salary range."

Forms Needed

Request for Title Change Memo Current Position Description

- 1. Only request a Title Change if the new title will better reflect the majority of the work being completed by the position or classification. Requesting a new title to cover "other duties as assigned" is unnecessary.
- 2. If the Title Change request is due to a change in industry standards or nomenclature, please also supply evidence of that (ie. Other job postings).
- 3. A Title Change request cannot be based upon a change of job duties.
- 4. Keep in mind that requesting unusual job titles may hurt since many applicants use databases to sift through keywords when searching for jobs.
- 5. The request and position description will be reviewed to determine if the new title accurately describes the role of the position or classification.
- 6. The Director of Administration may approve these requests without a resolution to the County Board.
