Thank you for the opportunity to submit a 2019 budget request to Dane County for the Dane County Historical Society. Receiving financial support from the County has allowed the Historical Society to continue its mission to: promote awareness of Dane County's rich heritage and aid in its preservation and dissemination of that history through our historical marker program, special events and programs, publications and the Otto Schroeder Records Center.

Therefore, we are requesting \$5,094.00 for the year 2019.

Highlights from our activities in 2017 include:

- Reviving local history *Networking Meetings*. The Fitchburg Historical Society and the Wisconsin Historical Society were our co-sponsors for a meeting in September at which 11 local history organizations were represented.
- Participating in the *Dane County Parks'* 13th Annual Harvest Moon Festival as an exhibitor.
- Dedicating a *new historical marker* in the Town of Primrose discussing the early years of "Fighting Bob" La Follette.
- Sponsoring a *Wisconsin Book Festival Author Event*, featuring Michael Edmonds and his then newest book, "Warriors, Saints, and Scoundrels."
- Hosting Jim Draeger and his "Bottoms' Up!" presentation at our *Annual Meeting & Open House*.

Attached is a more detailed summary of our activities which took place in 2017. We hope to build upon them with more special programming in 2018 to celebrate the history of Dane County and look forward to reaching more residents of Dane County with the work that we do.

Dane County Historical Society's 2017 Activity Report for the Dane County Department of Administration

We are very proud of all that the Dane County Historical Society (DCHS) accomplished in 2017, thanks in large part to the financial support given by Dane County. Highlights from last year include:

- The Dane County Historical Society revived local history *Networking Meetings* with a 2017 Local History Networking and Collaboration Event. On September 23rd, over 20 local historians from 11 historical societies attended the 2017 Local History Meeting at the Fitchburg Public Library. This event was organized in partnership with the Fitchburg Historical Society, Wisconsin Historical Society and the Wisconsin Council for Local History. It provided a wonderful opportunity for local historical societies to gather together to network, collaborate and discuss websites and social media. Historical societies were invited from Dane County, Rock County and Green County. Rick Bernstein, Local History-Field Services Representative for the Southern Region from the Wisconsin Historical Society (WHS), and John Decker, president of the Wisconsin Council for Local History (WCLH) provided updates on activities at the Wisconsin Historical Society and from WCLH.
- On October 13th, the Dane County Historical Society participated in the *Dane County Parks'* 13th Annual Harvest Moon Festival as an exhibitor at the Lussier Family Heritage Center. Board members spoke to over 100 individuals and invited them to attend the upcoming historical marker dedication which was to take place that weekend.
- On October 15th, the Board dedicated a *new historical marker* in the Town of Primrose entitled "Robert M. La Follette: The Early Years." This was the 47th historical marker erected by the Dane County Historical Society. The marker discusses the former senator and governor's life from birth up through his early political positions, starting out as Dane County District Attorney at age 26 in 1881. Over 20 history-lovers attended the ceremony and reception at the Primrose Town Hall.
- The Dane County Historical Society sponsored a *Wisconsin Book Festival Author Event*, featuring Michael Edmonds and his then newest book, "Warriors, Saints, and Scoundrels" on November 4th. This event took place at the Wisconsin Historical Museum

- on the Square and more than 50 visitors were in attendance. This gave DCHS an opportunity to raise interest and increase its visibility in front of a larger audience.
- James Draeger, State Preservation Officer and author of the book "Bottom's Up!" was the speaker at our *Annual Meeting & Open House* on October 29th. Local craft beers and snacks were enjoyed during this engaging presentation as Mr. Draeger explained the rich history of taverns and breweries in Wisconsin. Attendees asked many questions and the program was a great success! Visitors also were able to see highlights from the new Anchor Bank Collection, and artifacts and correspondence from World War I soldier, Ernest Schuepbach, a Swiss Cook and Infantry Man in Company K, as well as several other items from the Otto Schroeder Records Center. Additionally, two new board members were elected to the DCHS Board of Directors at the meeting.
- At the end of 2017, there were 81 members signed up with the Dane County Historical Society. This included: 2 Business Memberships, 19 Family Memberships, 10 Golden Memberships, 48 Individual Memberships, and 2 Lifetime Memberships. 9 of the total memberships were new members for 2017.
